Guashan Court Auction Bazaar is Set to Open!

Implementing the Core Values of Justice and Compassion through Promoting Legal Compliance Education

Changhua Branch, Administrative Enforcement Agency, Ministry of Justice (hereinafter referred to as Changhua Branch) will hold the Guashan Court Auction Bazaar - Combined Auction of Movable and Immovable Assets on January 2, 2024 (Tuesday), and the first event to take place at 9:00 a.m. on that day will be the sale of various kinds of Lunar New Year's items in the parking lot next to the Local Tax Bureau of Changhua County, followed by the auction of items at the same location at 9:30 a.m. on the same day. Bidding for the auction items began at 9:30 a.m. on the same day at the same location.

The Changhua Branch will simultaneously implement legal compliance education sessions at the Guashan Court Auction Bazaar. In addition to inviting the tax authorities to educate the public about rental services, the Court Auction Bazaar - Little Clerks Learning Activity will be held, inviting 5th grade

students from the Hedong Elementary School in Hemei Township, Changhua County, to participate. Before the activity, an executive officer is assigned to the school to conduct a legal education program that will include an explanation of the of the law-enforcement authorities introduction of the items being auctioned off, and arrangements are made to have an expert give a live presentation on the rules and procedures of auctions. On the day of the event, specialists will give on-site lectures on the regulations and procedures of auctions, plan for little clerks to assist in the sale of various items and help public welfare organizations to sell their goods, and conduct a mock auction, so that the concept of legal compliance can be rooted in children by experiencing the foreclosure process firsthand.

In addition, justice and care have always been the philosophy of the Administrative Enforcement Agency, and the Changhua Branch invited the Huashan Social Welfare Foundation to set up a booth for charity sales. Formally established in 1999, the Huashan Social Welfare Foundation was founded to serve the elderly as its mission, and has been investing in free home services for the elderly with three disabilities (incapacitation, loss of dependence, and dementia) for many years. Currently, there are about 400 Community Angel Centers in the Taiwan, Penghu, Kinmen and Matsu, serving close 30,000 disadvantaged senior citizens, and on the day of the event, the Changhua Community Angel Centers of Changhua County will be present to set up booths and sell biscuits, beverages, and volunteers' handmade products. The Changhua Branch Office

invites the public to come together to care for the elders and show their love.

Apart from obtaining information about the Court Auction Bazaar and the items to be auctioned (sold) through the Changhua Branch's Facebook fan page (which can be linked to from the Changhua Branch's official homepage) or IG (account: chymoi168), visitors can also go to the Changhua Branch's official website, which can be linked to the homepage to provide an online viewing service for all the items to be auctioned and sold, regardless of the time and place of the sale, using a cell phone or computer. Not only can you view high-definition photo files, you can clearly observe the appearance of each item, the original price of the item being sold, its features and special bargains, as well as the order in which the items are labeled, but you can also learn more about the items in this auction by linking to the auction announcement.
