Using Tea for Tax Payment in the Face of the Pandemic, Changhua Branch to Sell the Tea on January 2, 2024

The Changhua Branch, Administrative Enforcement Agency, Ministry of Justice (hereinafter referred to as Changhua Branch), in order to assist tax-defaulting tea farmers to tide over the difficulties in their business after the COVID-19 pandemic, will hold the "Court Auction Bazaar" - a joint auction of movable and immovable assets on January 2, 2024 (Tuesday). The first auction to be held at 9:00 a.m. that day will feature the sale of Taiwan Xin Tea and Sweet Potato Leaf Milk Tea, which are grown and developed by Mr. Tseng, a tea farmer. Tea lovers should not miss this event.

According to Tseng, it is not a whimsical idea for him to use sweet potato leaves to make tea, but there is a story behind it that has many twists and turns. Mr. Tseng originally worked as the general manager of an interior decoration company in Taipei, and was awarded the National Invention Prize of the Republic of China for two consecutive years in 2003 and 2004. Later, when he learned that he could not obtain a patent for his invention and that tens of millions of dollars of hard work had gone down the drain, he suffered a sudden myocardial infarction, and the prolonged oxygen deprivation of his heart resulted in severe necrosis, which saved his life a few hours later after he was resuscitated from an operating room. During the surgery, Mr. Tsang had a hallucination and heard a voice saying, "Go grow sweet potato leaves! Mr. Tseng had a hallucination during his surgery.

In 2010, Mr. Tseng came to Changhua and started planting sweet potato leaves. In 2011, the maximum area planted with sweet potato leaves reached 17 hectares, but fate always seems to play jokes on him, as a factory fire that burned for about 10 hours caused the sweet potato leaves planted by Mr. Tseng to become seriously sick and the damage was estimated to be tens of millions of dollars. One night while sleeping, Mr. Tsang dreamed that a sweet potato leaf was floating on the surface of a large bowl of water, and when he drank it, there was an aroma of tea that greeted him. Mr. Tsang then went to the temple of Guan Sheng Di Jun at the Baoan Temple in Yunlin, where he was instructed by Guan Sheng Di Jun, who had granted him 17 shenhjiao of the sacred answers, to stop selling raw sweet potato leaves and to instead grow purple sweet potato leaves with a high nutritional content for the purpose of producing sweet potato leaf tea. For this reason, Mr. Tseng went to the Tea Industry Improvement Farm in Yu Chi Township to study tea-making for three years.

According to Mr. Tseng, after the COVID-19 pandemic, his business became very difficult, many activities were canceled,

customers were lost, and it was difficult to open up new sources of customers, which seriously affected his Taiwan Xin Tea sales, and made it difficult for him to generate funds and owe the business tax, health insurance fees, and so on. The Changhua Branch Office considered the fact that Mr. Tseng's tea farmer owed taxes due to the epidemic's impact on his operations and repeatedly expressed his willingness to pay, so it agreed to assist in the sale of the Taiwan Xin Tea and Sweet Potato Leaf Milk Tea provided by Mr. Tseng, and to offset the taxes with the sale price.On January 2, 2024, the Court Auction Bazaar at Guashan of the Changhua Branch Office invites you to come together to taste a cup of Sweet Potato Leaf Milk Tea Soup, which Mr. Tseng has poured out with his sincerity and passion, and which has been nourished by his body and soul and moisturized by his life.

In addition to the wide variety of sincere items for sale, the auction of auction items will begin at 9:30 a.m. at the same location, and the auction items will not miss a beat. There will be a total of 11 motorcycles, BMW, Toyota Camry and other famous cars for sale, as well as a brand-new and expensive domestic car, Nachijie, which is equipped with electric seats, 360-degree panoramic view, and electric sunroof, so you will be able to enjoy the auction without being tempted.
