The event will also include booths from the Nantou Branch of National Taxation Bureau of the Central Area, Ministry of Finance, Changhua County Local Tax Office, Changhua Prison of the Ministry of Justice, and the Changhua Station of Taichung Motor Vehicles Office, Highway Bureau, MOTC, among which the Changhua Prison will offer their products for sale. The Genesis Social Welfare Foundation's Changhua branch will also participate with a charity sale booth. This season's auction not only highlights 7 vehicles but also features a major share auction from a Class A Comprehensive Construction Activities, which has attracted significant attention. This company's shares have come under the hammer due to unpaid estate taxes enforced by the Beidou Office National Taxation Bureau of the Central Area. To prevent non-serious bidding, a deposit of NT\$2 million is required at the time of registration for those interested in purchasing these shares.

The "Guashan Court Auction Market" is renowned for its rich assortment of practical, reasonably priced items that draw crowds every season. This edition sees the restocking of popular items like "Sun-Link-Sea" tea, support belts, sports equipment, the Guo Hot Pot vouchers, peeled freen peppers, and fermented black bean fish. New products introduced this season include longevity noodles, popcorn, mesona tea, apple cider vinegar, and garlic chili, along with practical kitchen and dining utensils like draining fresh-keeping boxes, cast iron pots, 304 stainless steel lunch boxes, honey pots, coasters, trays, hinoki storage boxes, thermos, and Japanese and Korean style chopsticks. Ladies' accessories like scarves, clutch bags, pink umbrellas, and face masks are also available, perfect for festival gifting. Other practical items such as camping lights, knee pads, back supports, wrist guards, masks, blind-spot detection systems, and Bluetooth tire pressure monitoring systems are also part of the inventory. For families with students, the Wen-Chang pens promising academic success are also on sale.

In celebration of Children's Day, the Branch is currently hosting the "Childlike Spirit for the People Coloring Contest", with heated competition evidenced by the enthusiastic social media interaction.
