Guashan Court Auction Bazaar Charity Event Completed with Great Success!

The Changhua Branch, Administrative Enforcement Agency, Ministry of Justice held the “Guashan Court Auction Bazaar - Sending Love and Warmth” joint auction of movable assets on July 2, 2024 (Tuesday) at its Nantou office. In addition to nearly 100 kinds of products for participants to choose from, there were also booths set up by public welfare organizations, as well as information sessions by the Veterans' Service Office and taxation authorities. The Nantou County Certified Public Bookkeepers Association and the Chinese Industrial and Commercial Taxation Association also joined the event. With the promotion of the Changhua Branch Office through a number of creative marketing videos posted on the official Facebook page, all staff members were eager to serve the guests despite the blazing sunshine on that day and the laborious efforts to set up the venue. Many people arrived early in the morning for the event and shopped for their favorite items, among which the Shanlinxi tea leaves were sold out as soon as they were put on sale. The total proceeds from the auction and sale of real estate on that day amounted to NT\$97,085, although modest, it was a token of appreciation from all the staff, participating organizations and the public.

On the day of the event, an unboxing event was held to unveil the ultra-low-priced items for sale - a juicer and a frying pan - and the selling price was only revealed on the spot. As the prices were extremely favorable, equivalent to 40% to 50% off the market price, and only one of each of the two items was offered for sale by the obligors, interested parties were required to leave a message on the Branch's official Facebook page in order to be eligible to participate in the auction lottery, and the lucky winners were drawn publicly after the completion of the auction process in the auction area, and the winners were all overjoyed. In addition, for the capital contribution of the Class A integrated manufacturing company, one of the original bidders registered for the auction, but eventually lost the bidding because the bid did not reach the reserve price, and missed the opportunity to become the owner of a construction company. The highest bidder in the afternoon auction of real estate was a piece of land in Ershui Township, Changhua County, with a bid of NT\$360,000.

The Changhua Branch cooperates with the Administrative Enforcement Agency's "123 Joint Auction", which is held on the first Tuesday of every month. In order to serve a wider range of customers, the centralized auction of movable assets is sometimes held in Changhua and sometimes in Nantou. In addition, in order to alleviate people's troubles in traveling, real estate auctions are held on-site as well as through telecommunication bidding, which facilitates people in placing bids and prevents bid-rigging, thus interested people are advised to pay close attention to the Facebook and official website of the Branch Office and pay attention to the latest news of the Branch Office's activities. In particular, the Changhua Branch would like to remind the public that they should not ignore the notification of the subpoena by the Branch by assuming that it is the work of a fraudulent group. Pay your taxes honestly, do not leave things to chance, and work together to eliminate fraud!
